## Important Notes

1. It is recommended to permanently install the Gallon Collector Lid as shown in these instructions. Using both lids together or changing between lids may lead to vacuum leaks.
2. Pump down times will increase with larger empty volumes.

- Tip: To reduce pump down times with smaller batches the collector can be partially filled with clean solvent.

3. Verify that the tubing connections are correct before use.

- The new tube with white printing \& fitting connects to the existing tube with white printing.
- The new tube with black printing \& fitting connects to the existing tube with black printing.

Cut tubing approximately 1 " above the old collector lid (Location shown with red indicators.)


## Installing the 1 Gallon Collector Lid

 WITH WHITE LETTERING

INSTALL BLACK FITTING TO TUBING WITH BLACK LETTERING

If it is difficult to push the tubing onto the barb see next page for a tip.

## Tip to help install tubing

Try this if it is difficult to push the tubing over the barb with your hands.

Tool needed: A small pair of needle nose pliers.


1. Insert tip of pliers into end tubing

2. Quickly insert barb into the expanded tube.
3. Pull the pliers handles apart to stretch tubing
